He was investigated thoroughly at another hospital where he did many investigations. He was advised by another neurologist to try Memantine and follow up PET scan later which he agreed. Currently he is taking Carbamazepine for epilepsy control which seems to show good response.

Dr. Ketchai Suavansri in Bumrungrad Hospital assesses seizures as a secondary effect of MS. Its very clear that I have absence seizures.

But the medications for seizures aren't recommended since it may cause worsening effects in MS.

Additive Illegality in Not Acknowledging or Investigating the Cause of Seizures

There is an additive illegality in the state of Massachusetts, United States to not acknowledge seizures when there is evidence of seizures.

All people who exhibit seizures are required to report it the state of Massachusetts Department of Motor Vehicles in order to prevent motor vehicle accidents in those who have seizures while operating a vehicle. And neurologists are required to investigate it to determine the underlying cause of the seizures (in my case MS) also to prevent motor vehicle accidents. Thus the illegality of falsified medical data causes an additively illegal situation in operating a motor vehicle in Massachusetts, putting me and other motorists in danger due to medical negligence.
