1. What persecution do you fear?

I fear physical and intellectual disfigurement, some of which has partially been achieved in the clinical mistreatment of my neurodegenerative condition, secondary progressive multiple sclerosis. The perpetuators of this type of harm are medical doctors that are practicing intentional medical negligence both in the US and as directed by the US abroad, with clear and explicit evidence (its well substantiated). Most of it is criminal with evidence.

I also fear the US using the clinical effects of my syndrome to harm me in settings outside of medical settings. People with MS have particular effects like emotional incontinence (inability to manage emotional states) called pseudobulbar effects, which is typical of those with a neurodegenerative condition. The US has often tried to build a character mystification using the clinical effects of the neurodegenerative condition.

The idea is, ignore that the clinical syndrome, mistreat it and then use the clinical effects of the condition to create a personality typification for discrimination in other settings. For example in social or job place settings.

I also fear that the US will use the clinical syndrome to the point of impoverishment.

2. Why are you being targeted? What characteristic do you have that is a reason for persecution?

I believe I am being targeted due to a perpetuated effect. Eg. Due to a lengthy course of medical negligence in the past, it has become a perpetuated case where the medical negligence leads to more medical negligence in an attempt to not admit to past instances of medical negligence. If a doctor acknowledged the underlying reason for my clinical condition they would also be admitting to the clinical negligence and criminality that took place in the past. They are afraid of the legal consequence of acknowledging the condition so they keep creating more instance of medical negligence and assault. Then to further not admit to it, the medical boards (which are comprised of physicians) are further instructed to deny investigation of the clear medical negligence. This is likely the reason why doctors in the UK have tried to replicate the situation in the US, in order for them to not suffer the legal consequences of their clinical negligence.

Thus it has become a become a situation where there are more and more instances of clinical fraud and assaults in medical settings where I am often in sever need for the medications because it is a progressive neurodegenerative condition that often requires hospital visits.

3. What persecution have you suffered in the past?

The list is extensive 47 instances of fraud, negligence, and clinical assaults in medical settings with clear evidence and with the intent of physical harm and disfigurement all with clear evidence spanning a medical mistreatment case in 12 years. (from 2008 to 2020).

There is denial of legal representation and investigation to stop the malice in medical settings within the US and as directed by the US in foreign nations.

There is of course the physical suffering from the effects of the perpetuated clinical syndrome leaving the patient is either sever physical pain 24/7 or an inability to move his limbs in sever phases of the clinical syndrome. Along with daily seizures which causes the typical effects of seizures.

Beyond this there is clear social and job place discrimination in the US using the effects of the clinical syndrome while hiding the clinical syndrome which is the intent. Build a personality typification while ignoring the clinical syndrome.

There is also malice using social media and malice in public settings.

4. Can you seek protection from the state? If not, why not?

No there is no protection in the US form this type of malice. If I report it to the police they will state that its the responsibility of the medical board of the state. If I report it to the medical board the medical board will deny investigation (like in the UK) to protect the doctors that perpetuated negligence.

If I seek a solicitor or a lawyer I am denied legal representation in the US, 20-40 lawyers in each state where the negligence happened. The negligence and clinical fraud happened in Massachusetts, New York, Florida, Ohio, California, Washington State, and Arizona.

5. Can you live somewhere else in the USA?

There is no part of the country (US) where I could be safe form the medical negligence and persecution since it has become a national issue in medical negligence.
