Hello Mr. Korff,

Do you take criminal cases in medicine?

I have a medical negligence case stemming from Berlin Charity Hospital and I spoke to a lawyers office in Hanover, Germany that specializes in medical negligence. They stated that there are criminal offenses in question before instances of medical negligence takes place in Berlin Charity.

Thus they recommended a criminal lawyer in Berlin.

The criminal offense is a falsification of an important medical document (they called it inter alia falsification of a document; the document is a Lumbar Puncture test report) to perpetuate negligence in a medical setting. The negligence in turn causes further harm (neuro spinal degeneration of the brain and spine) by mis representing a clinical syndrome by falsifying a medical document. The medical condition is Multiple Sclerosis and its easy to show how falsifying documents eventually caused further harm through negligence in my case.
