# Dr. Valentine Riteri - NYC Psych Doctor

In March of 2014 I saw Dr. Riteri in NYC as stated by Dr. Kimberly Menzer in the NYU clinical (under Dr. Soujel Najjar) report. There were two appointments, both about 25 minutes.

Dr. Valentine is not a treating physician nor did he do any diagnostics (no diagnostics and no prescriptions); he is cited but he is an irrelevant doctor to mention.

Most of what was discussed in the appointment were the typical effects from MS. I stated that I was going progressively blind, I pointed to the picture in the far end of the room and stated that colors in the painting are pale and washed out, which is typical of optic neuropathy in Multiple Sclerosis. I also stated that I have pseudobulbar effect (which was later shown to be true because I have inflammatory lesions in the midbrain from MS).

I also described the extreme headaches and physical pain from the condition, which was imaged as lesions along the cervical spinal column. No doctor could ever confuse my statements as being psychiatric condition but there was an attempt made to do so.

There was no appropriate clinical evaluation by the doctor, no medications were prescribed by the doctor, and there was no follow up with the doctor ever again. He is a non treating physician. Only two appointments and no follow-up.

Most of the symptoms described were pertaining to neurology. I described the neuralgia from MS as "neuropathic pain". The neuralgia is derived from gross lesions in the spinal column.

Nothing we discussed was psychiatric in nature. Most topics involved blood glucose, optic neuropathy, and neuralgia (pain along hands, legs, and spinal column) from progressive multiple sclerosis.
