- **Dr. Bruce Price - Belmont, Massachusetts, USA**
  - **Criminal Negligence →**

The negligence and malice in a medical setting in the hospital in Belmont Massachusetts becomes apparent when Dr. Evan Murray's colleague Dr. Bruce Price is consulted on July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2009. Both are neurologists in the same hospital and Dr. Bruce Price is Dr. Evan Murray's senior. It shows the repeated attempts at ignoring gross presentation in a MRI series or denying additional required tests to withhold treatment.

Dr. Price perpetuates the medical negligence of Dr. Evan Murray. Its equivalent to ignoring a brain tumor or a stroke due its prominence and was illegal at that point in time. It eventually becomes criminal due to medical falsifications thereafter (intentional medical falsification to harm a patient).

Having medical evidence of clear neurological pathology and refusing to do a more involved investigation is medically inappropriate. Dr. Price tries to mis typify the physical pain during the appointment. The physical pain was caused by lesions along the cervical spine which eventually causes progressive neurodegeneration in a secondary progressive form of MS.

It is apparent that I do suffer from pseudobulbar effect (a common effect in Multiple Sclerosis) at that moment in time as well, its mentioned in the scheduling of his appointment:

Subjective: Naren is scheduled to see Bruce Price on July 28, 2009. He asked me to resend my letter to him, which I did today. He describes continuing to experience that his environment is extremely intense, that he has powerful emotional reactions to ordinary humdrum. I asked if it felt like the environment was intruding on him.

I believe Dr. Price was trying to be artful in an attempt to avoid medical treatment but his medical statements also appear to be a way of avoiding doing an investigation into the condition or to be evasive.

Most patients with these medical findings are required to have a lumbar puncture test and repeated brain spine MRIs to check for inflammation in the entire spinal column along with blood tests to shows the toxicological underpinning of the condition. Plasmapheresis would be necessitated in 2009.

Thought at that point in time it would be considered negligence, criminal fraud and criminal negligence becomes apparent when it was determined that MRI series images were being hidden or erased to try and hide the disease pathology. Falsifying medical data to hide disease pathology or progression is apparent in over a decade of mistreatment in the United States.

Thought Dr. Price is mentioned in other medical reports his report is missing from the record.
