In March of 2014 I saw Dr. Riteri in NYC as recommended by Dr. Kimberly Menzer in NYU Hospital (under Dr. Soujel Najjar). There were two appointments, both about 25 minutes where the doctor had limited medical records to reference. Dr. Valentine is mentioned in the report by Dr. Kimberley Menzer but he was only seen twice for a 25 minute appointment and isn't a treating physician that did any diagnostics (no diagnostics and no prescriptions); he is irrelevancy.

Most of what was discussed in the appointment were the typical effects from MS. I stated that I was going progressively blind, I pointed to the picture in the far end of the room and stated that colors in the painting are pale and washed out, which is typical of optic neuropathy in Multiple Sclerosis. I also stated that I have pseudobulbar effect (which was later shown to be true because I have inflammatory lesions in the midbrain from MS).

I also described the extreme headaches and physical pain from the condition, which was imaged as lesions along the cervical spinal column. No doctor could ever confuse my statements as being psychiatric condition but there was an attempt made to do so.

There was no appropriate clinical evaluation by the doctor, no medications were prescribed by the doctor, and there was no follow up with the doctor ever again. He is a non treating physician. Only two appointments and no follow-up.
