My uncle pictured this in this article, though he never played any role in my case may have died in relation to my case (its unsure). The location of his death indicates that it is related because he happened to be near the same place as where I get occasional medical treatment in New Delhi when it happens. But im not in India when it happens. I don't know why he is there.

My family has no involvement in this case because they have never been informed about the case by me. They don't have any external role and remains separate.

Moreover the case has no participation by family (either immediate or extended), its determined by lawyers in foreign nations and court physicians (physicians assigned by a legal court).

Those harming me a have a peculiar behavior where they harm arbitrary people at the risk that they would be found out, but family doesn't know. Its believed that they have harmed thousands of people, some said million of people at the idea that they are a risk from my case.



My uncle pictured above may have been harmed by those harming me in 2022 before July. He simply happens to be a doctor. So that ties into a risk for family. Since it's a international case, it could affect family.

The entire time period from May of 2021 to 2023 in a horrifying situation of them using this system to cause morbid harm to me and others; often arbitrary people. They said thousands were effected.

The location of my hospital treatment is in the south east of New Delhi in Apollo Hospital. And it seemed strange that a person from Madras India (my uncle) would be in New Delhi, India where he typically isn't when he died. The doctors in the hospital aren't related to my uncle. So I think its related. They said natural death but its too much of a coincidence that the location of his death is only a few miles from my hospital in New Delhi.

I wasn't in India at that point in time nor do I know anyone else there except my doctors in Indraprastha Apollo Hospital and the National Thalassemia Clinic. The family doesn't know that I have been to India to see a doctor in Apollo Hospital either (never informed them).
